- | ensuring we provide adequate information, instruction, training and supervision
- | establishing robust, clear processes across defined project stages, with procedures to ensure we are not just safe on paper, but safe in reality
- | ensuring we provide a safe and healthy environment for all our people and associated third parties
- | constantly striving to prevent incidents, and should an incident occur, vigorously investigating and sharing our findings to prevent any reoccurrence.

The executive board of HE Simm is responsible for complying with the relevant, current legislation that governs our business and associated activities. This is achieved by establishing the overall Health and Safety Policy, cascading this information to colleagues and reviewing the performance of the business overall.

The chief executive officer is responsible for:

- | providing an effective process of assurance with the aim of continually developing our methods and improving the health and safety culture.


It is the responsibility of every employee, subcontractor and associated third party to:
